We have offended against thy holy laws. We have left undone those things which we ought to have done; And we have done those things which we ought not to have done; And there is no health in us. But thou, O Lord, have mercy upon us miserable offenders, Spare thou those, O God, who confess their faults. Restore thou those who are penitent; according to thy promise declared unto mankind in Christ Jesus our Lord. And grant O most merciful Father; for his sake; That we may hereafter live a godly, righteous and sober life. To the glory of thy holy Name. Amen
